


EPAYF Fellowship


Our environmental programs have successfully engaged a diverse and influential network of over 1,500 participants, demonstrating both a broad pan-India presence across 25+ states and a growing international footprint in **more than 10 countries**. This vibrant cohort represents a strategic blend of future and current leaders: 41% are students from premier institutions like the University of Delhi, JNU, and TISS, while the remaining participants are established professionals from the non-profit (18%), academic/research (24%), and corporate (12%) sectors. 


